Scholarship Description

This one-time scholarship will be awarded to a student and/or students in the current graduating class of Monroe High School who have been involved with the Monroe Wrestling Program (youth - high school), and may include a manager. The amount of the scholarship will be based on the student's wrestling experience/involvement. As part of the application process, the student must be in good academic standing, must NOT have had any Code of Conduct violations in high school, show some involvement with school/community activities, indicate where you will continue your education after graduation, and write an essay that includes what Monroe Wrestling means to you and how this sport has helped you grow as a person.

Amount of Scholarship

Based on the level of participation in wrestling. The scholarship will be a one-time scholarship.
